To all to whom these presents shall come, greeting: Whereas Dila Cecilia Cox of Eureka County, Nevada has deposited with the Register of the State Land Office at Carson City, the State Treasury Receipt, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Dila Cecilia Cox, according to the provisions of an act of the Legislature, approved March 12, 1885, entitled "An act to provide for the selection and sale of lands that have been or may hereafter be granted by the United States to the State of Nevada;" and the acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, for the South East Quarter of the North West Quarter and the North East Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section twenty-two (22) Township twenty-four (24) North Range Fifty-four (54) East, number thirty, Base and Meridian, containing Eighty

acres, according to the official Plat of the Survey
of the Public Lands, as made by the United
States Surveyor-General for the District of Nevada,
which said tract has been purchased by the said
Dila Cecilia Cof.

Wherefore, know ye, That the State of Nevada, in
consideration of the premises, and in conformity
