- I, Vivian Eileen Penrod, of Elko, , Nevada, MAKE OATH AND SAY THAT:
- I, Vivian Eileen Penrod of Elko, Nevada, born in Ca., moving to Diamond Valley Eureka, NV in 1946 at the age of 18-19 mos. with my family, father Theodore M., mother Olive, brother Milton and my baby sister Joyce Thompson. I did not leave Diamond Valley until graduating from Eureka High School in the year of 1963 to obtain a nursing degree.

There was an abundance of water at all the the areas I will mention. There were 2 large bodies of water at home ranch which we referred to as lg. pond, and "round" pond just a sm distance north of the lg. pond. These 2 bodies of water, watered all the meadows at home ranch, south side and north side with an abundance flowing and seeping on out side of both fields and there was also a large grass pasture area to on the lower north side where cattle watered daily and bedded on a medium size nole which is still a popular area for the cattle to lay in sun when coming in daily, now for water the the new owner Dan and his wife Mandi have to pipe from a well up at foothill above the ranch house, which was drilled so there could be water in the house and other areas for livestock to water.

2. Hay was put up at all other areas of deeded property, Cox place, Willow field, Rock pasture and Rock field and the Mau place. All these fields had an abundance of water from natural springs being on each causing problems during haying time like getting stuck in the overly wet areas. The State of NV & Eureka County official successfully achieved their goals of TOTALLY drying ALL the natural flowing springs up starting in the 80's if not sooner of issuing too many well apps for farmers growing hay in south end of valley. All the lands with surplus natural spring waters have dried up and nice meadow grasses is replaced with an over supply of rabbit brush that has no use and nothing is able eat. It was heart breaking and brought tears to my eyes when realizing both the large bodies of water at home ranch were totally DRIED UP! The old haystack enclosures where hay was stacked can still be found in most of the fields and at the home ranch often at more than one location.
