It would be wiser to cooperate with California on a pipeline to move sea water into the Death Valley Dry Seabed where sedimentation would do most of the work of purification and any additional processing could be done. This would also be a valuable water resource for putting out any fires that might occur, allowing shorter and more frequent flights from the Pacific Ocean to refill tanker planes depending on the size of any fire.
