Dear Ms. Joseph-Taylor:

We are following up with a revised hard copy of our emailed inquiry about public comment, which was prompted by the fact that the group of protestants we represent, including local governmental entities and citizens' organizations, have been receiving inquiries from concerned members of the public who believe they should have an opportunity to provide comment on the important issues that Judge Estes remanded for reconsideration.

Before sending our inquiry to you, we reached out to counsel for the other parties actively participating in this remand proceeding. No one objected, and counsel for the Southern Nevada Water Authority (SNWA) proposed setting aside a half day on Friday, September 29, for members of the public to give oral comment. A copy of that email correspondence with counsel of record and your office is attached in chronological order as Exhibit A.

September 29 comes at the end of the week that has been set aside for SNWA's case, so it would not impinge on the four-and-a-half days available during the week of October 2-6 for the protestants' respective cases. Because the protestants must fit all of their presentations into that limited time during the second week of the remand hearing, no time is available for oral public comment during that week.

We think it would be a mistake to treat the issues on remand as being so narrow as not to merit public comment. That view does not square with Judge Estes' decision, which placed central importance, and based its reversal of the State Engineer's 2012 rulings, on those issues. Such a narrow characterization of the issues also is inconsistent with the repeated arguments by both the State Engineer and SNWA in the State courts that these issues are of great public consequence and concern, which seems to be borne out by the public interest that has been expressed.

Accordingly, we respectfully propose that the State Engineer set aside half the day on September 29 for oral comment during the remand hearing. Because many concerned and potentially affected people live and work far from Carson City we also believe that, whether or not time is made available for oral public comment during the hearing, the public should be provided with

the opportunity to submit written comments to the State Engineer through October 20, 2017, two weeks after the end of the remand hearing. That would allow members of the public to take the information presented during the hearing into account in their written comments without delaying the State Engineer's ruling on remand.

Enclosed with the two copies of this letter being filed with the State Engineer's Office is an additional copy of the letter along with a self-addressed stamped envelope. Please file stamp and mail us that copy of this letter.

Good morning all, please be reminded that official filings in this matter are not accepted via email. They must be delivered either in person or through the US mail, with an attached service list and be timestamped in this office. The Division of Water Resources is not set up for electronic filing.

I also note that the email list does not seem to match that identified in the cc list on the actual letter or the proper service list for this matter. When I hit "Reply All" it shows Steven Carter as a recipient, but Mr. Carter has not appeared as presenting his own case in this matter. It also does not identify Mr. Sev Carlson nor Mr. Jerald Anderson and I do not see Mr. Anderson's name in the cc list in the letter and both have made official appearances in this matter.

I had not anticipated reopening public comment. The court remanded the matter to the State Engineer for the consideration of very specific issues and the hearing will be confined to those issues. Public comment was already conducted for this hearing. We have a limited amount of time and fairly significant witness lists; therefore, I don't know if we have time to reopen oral public comment and I don't know that it is warranted.

I was anticipating that the first week would be set aside for the Applicant SNWA to present its witnesses and the second week would be for the Protestants to present their witnesses. Is the SNWA agreeing to forgo ½ day of its hearing time for public comment? Remember, we only have ½ day on Thursday, Oct. 5<sup>th</sup>. Are all the parties in agreement to reopen public comment? If so, I would anticipate only written public comment. If I allow written public comment, how long would you anticipate leaving the record open? Are all parties in agreement as to the timeframe set aside for presentation of their witnesses?

I apologize for any confusion that may have resulted from my emailing our inquiry about public comment.

We did not go through the normal filing process because we did not view our inquiry about public comment as a formal filing, and emailed it to you in the interests of time. We used Paul Taggart's September 28, 2016, email submitting the proposed interim ruling to you as a guide, and meant to cover the same counsel as that email. Steven Carter's email address was the result of my oversight in not noticing that my computer erroneously inserted Mr. Carter's email address when I started to type Sev Carlson's email address (the two begin similarly). I simply forgot to include Jerald Anderson because he was not included in the list of addressees from that September email which I was using as a guide.
